Logline

A tech-savvy teenager saves her father from breaking new AI laws by stopping him from killing off the entities in his simulation, only to realize that their civilization resembles our own world so much that it's likely that we are also living in a simulation.

Synopsis

Near-future: 2027 or 2028. A tech-savvy teenager discovers that her father, tech industry titan and CTO of a major AI company, has an off-the-books project with three of his tech industry buddies creating massive simulations of human civilizations, using a loophole around a new law banning the killing of AI entities. She enlists the help of four fellow "AI Club" students to hack into the system and prevent the civilizations from destroying themselves. Their interventions cause the AI entities to have visions, create new religions, and ultimately see UFOs and aliens. As the simulation careens towards the same AI and UFO Disclosure Singularities looming in our own world, she realizes that we ourselves are most likely also a simulation. The final-scene twist is that the simulation is in fact our own world, that she and her father are our creators or gods, and that the biblical "end times" are what happens when these worlds simultaneously reach this singularity.
